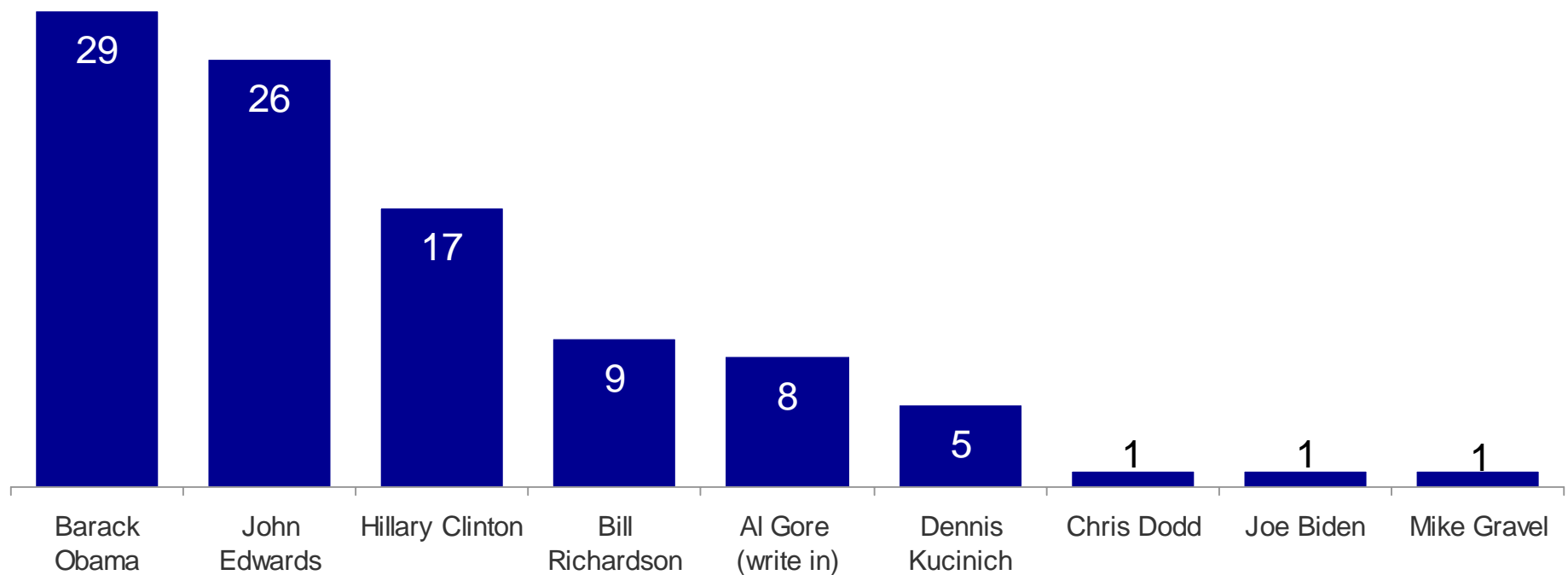

The 2008 primary elections are still a long way off, but if you were to vote in the Democratic primary election and the candidates were the ones listed below -- for whom would you vote?

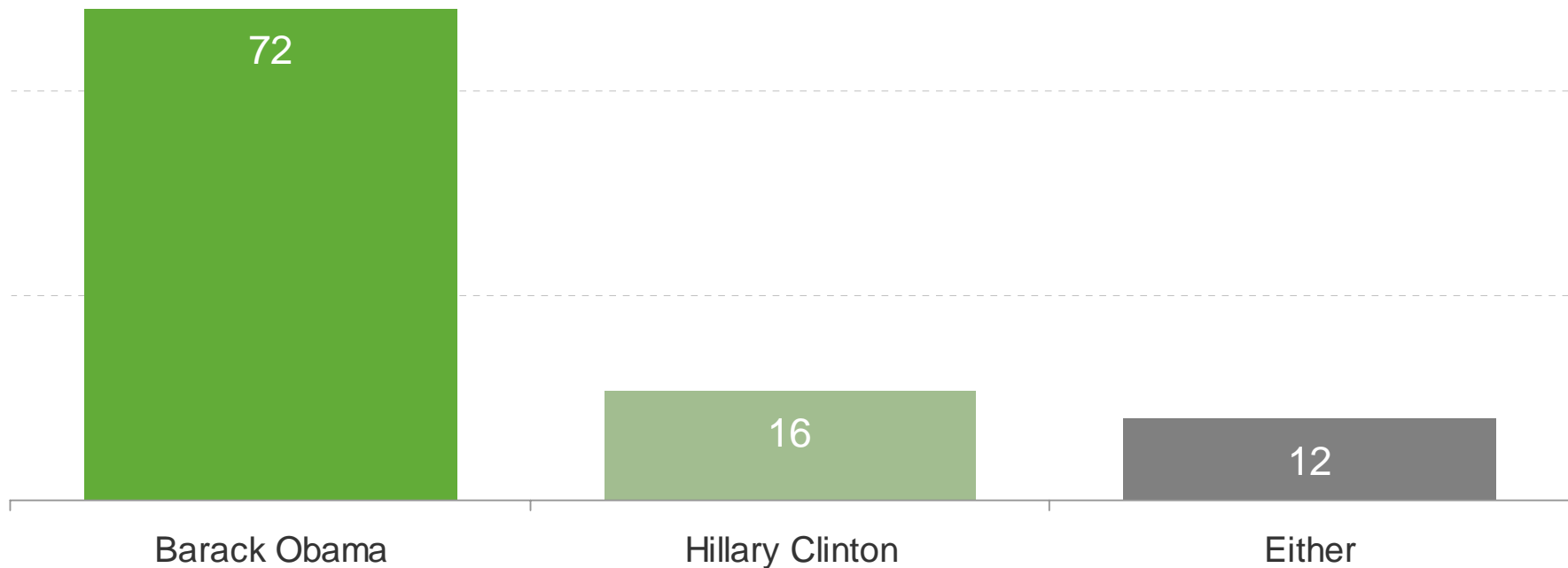

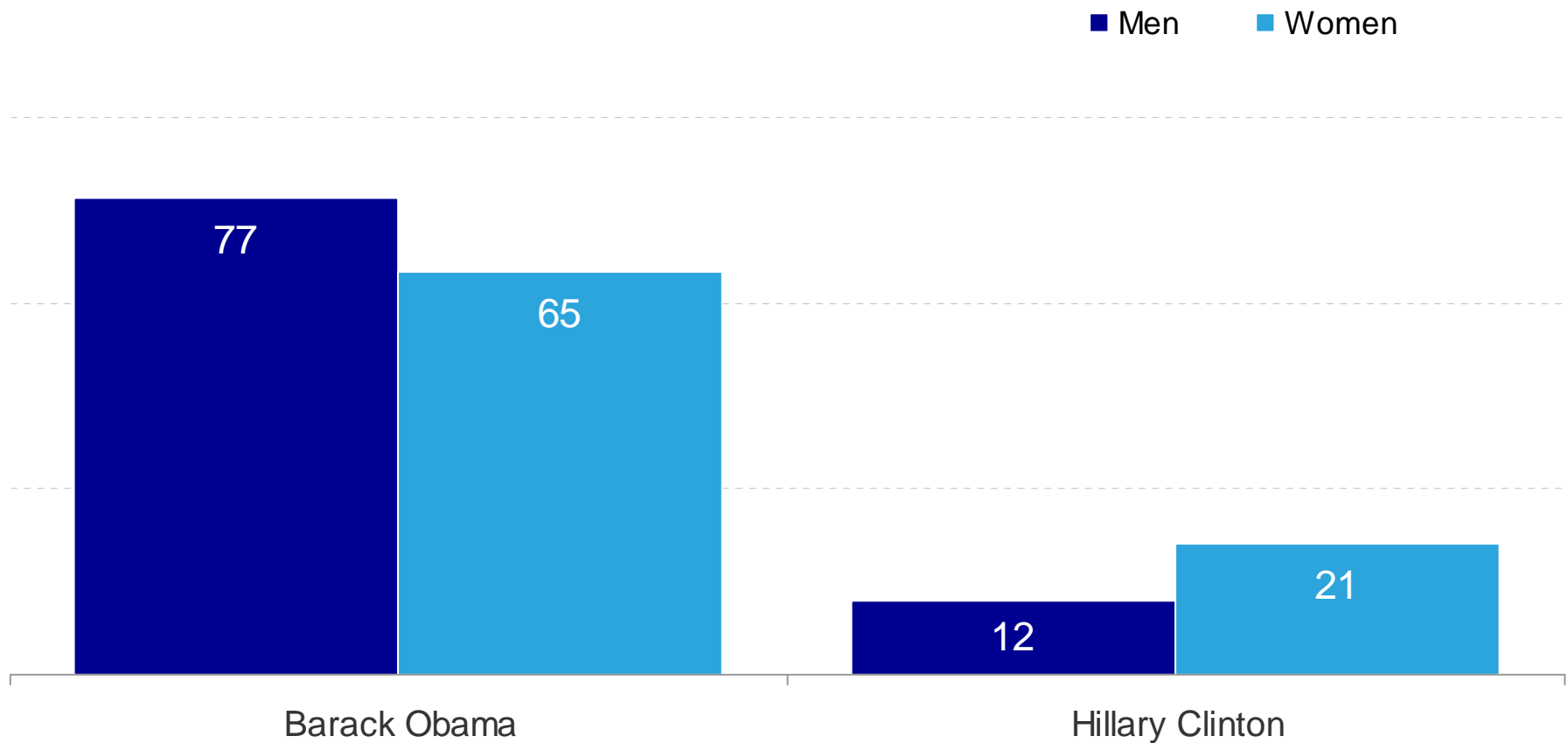
Who would you MOST like to see nominated as the Democratic Party's presidential candidate this year: Hillary Clinton or Barack Obama?

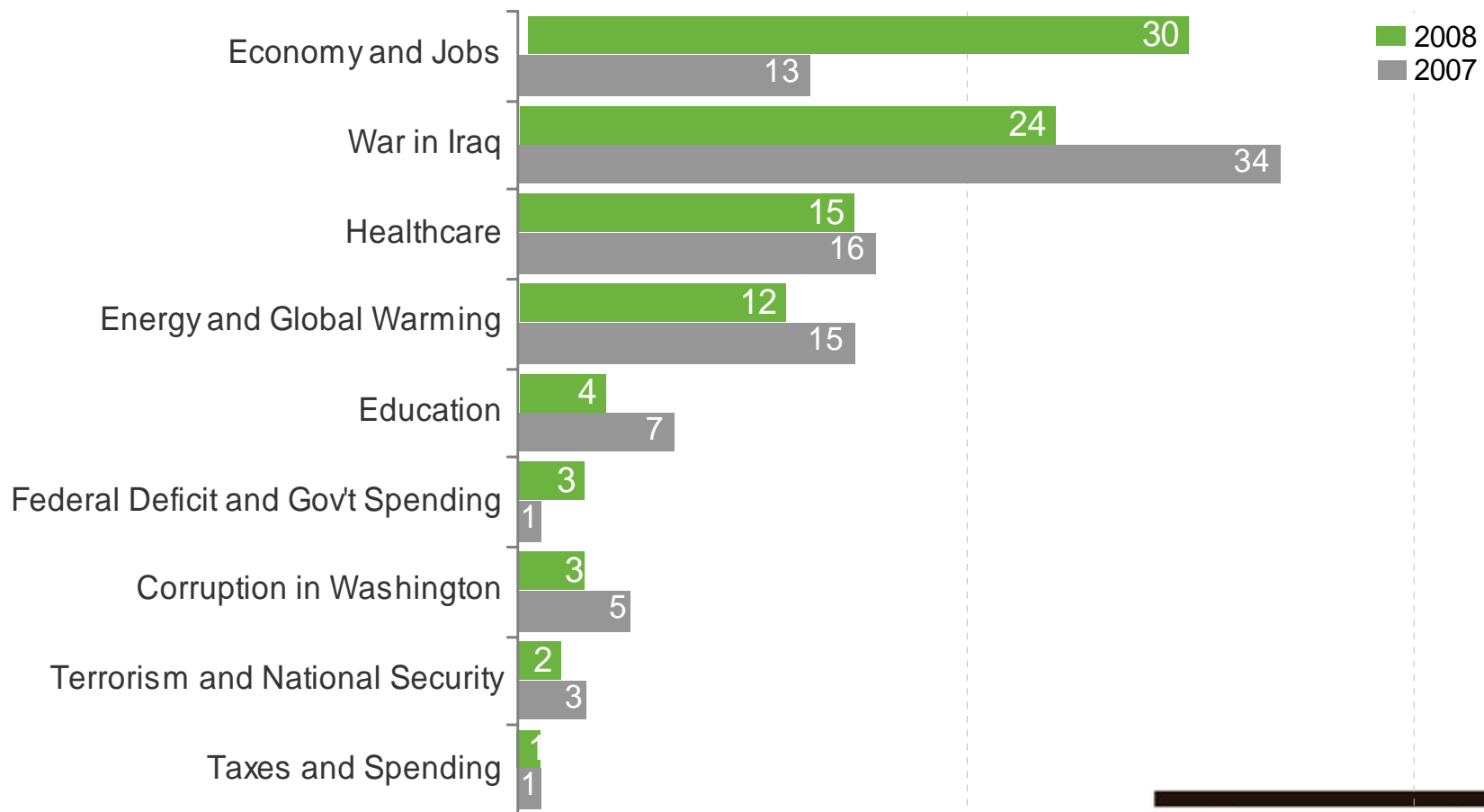
Women show stronger support for Clinton than men

Economy and war trade spots as top issue since last year's conference

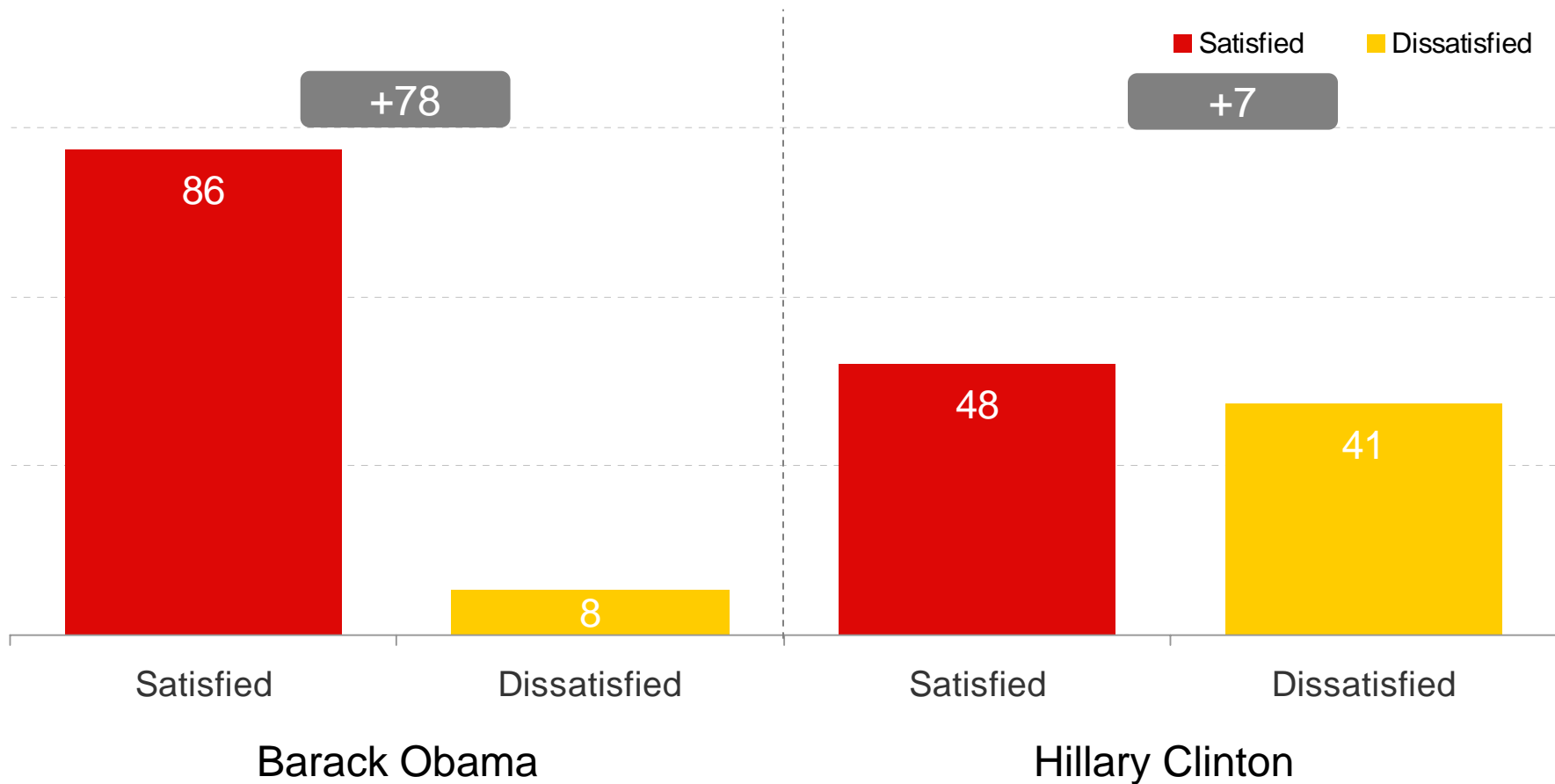
Of the list of concerns below, please indicate which ONE of these you think the president and Congress should be paying the most attention to.

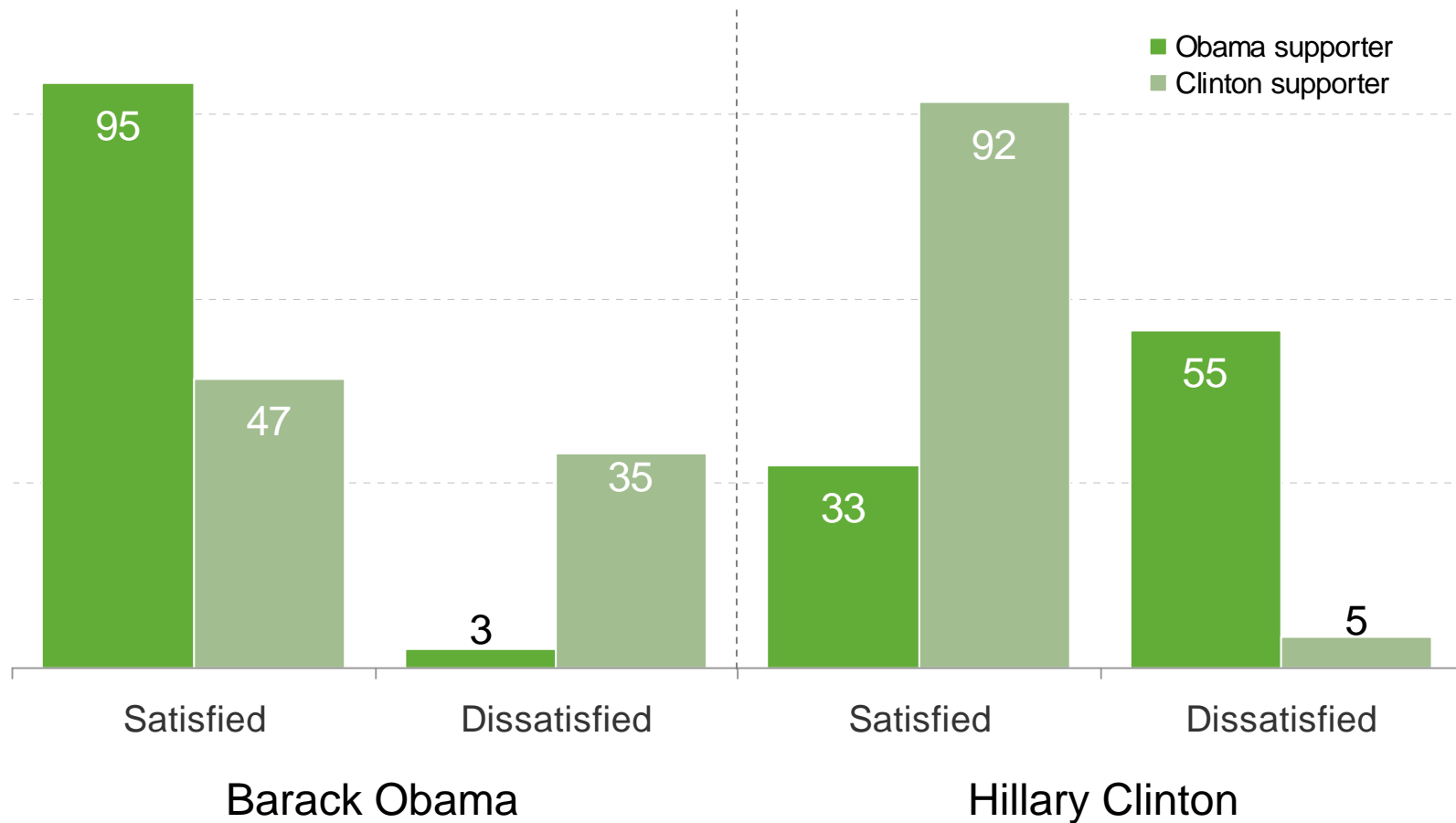
Attendees satisfied with Obama as nominee, Clinton as well

Regardless of who you are supporting for the Democratic nomination, how would you feel if Hillary Clinton were the nominee?



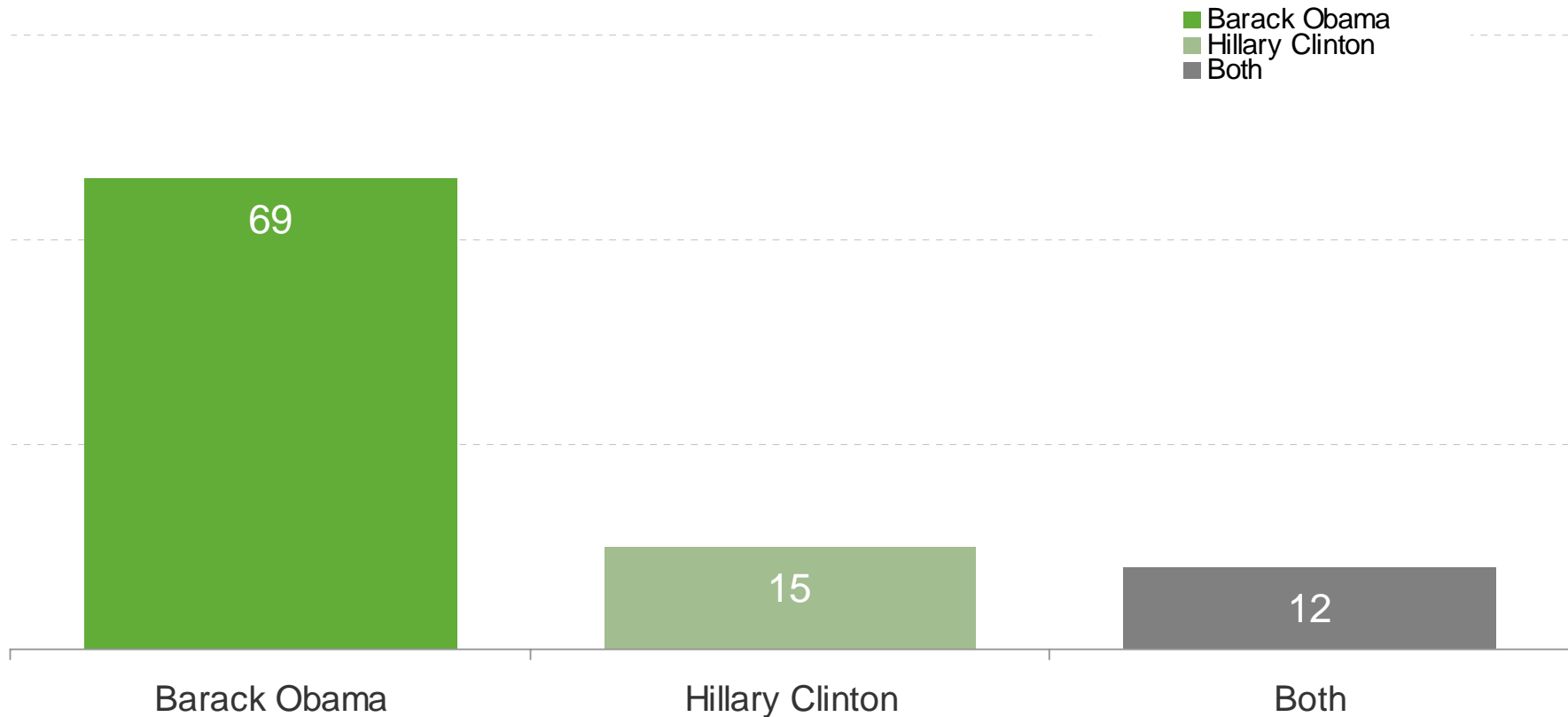
Satisfaction lags somewhat for candidate other than own

Regardless of who you are supporting for the Democratic nomination, how would you feel if (Barack Obama/Hillary Clinton) were the nominee?



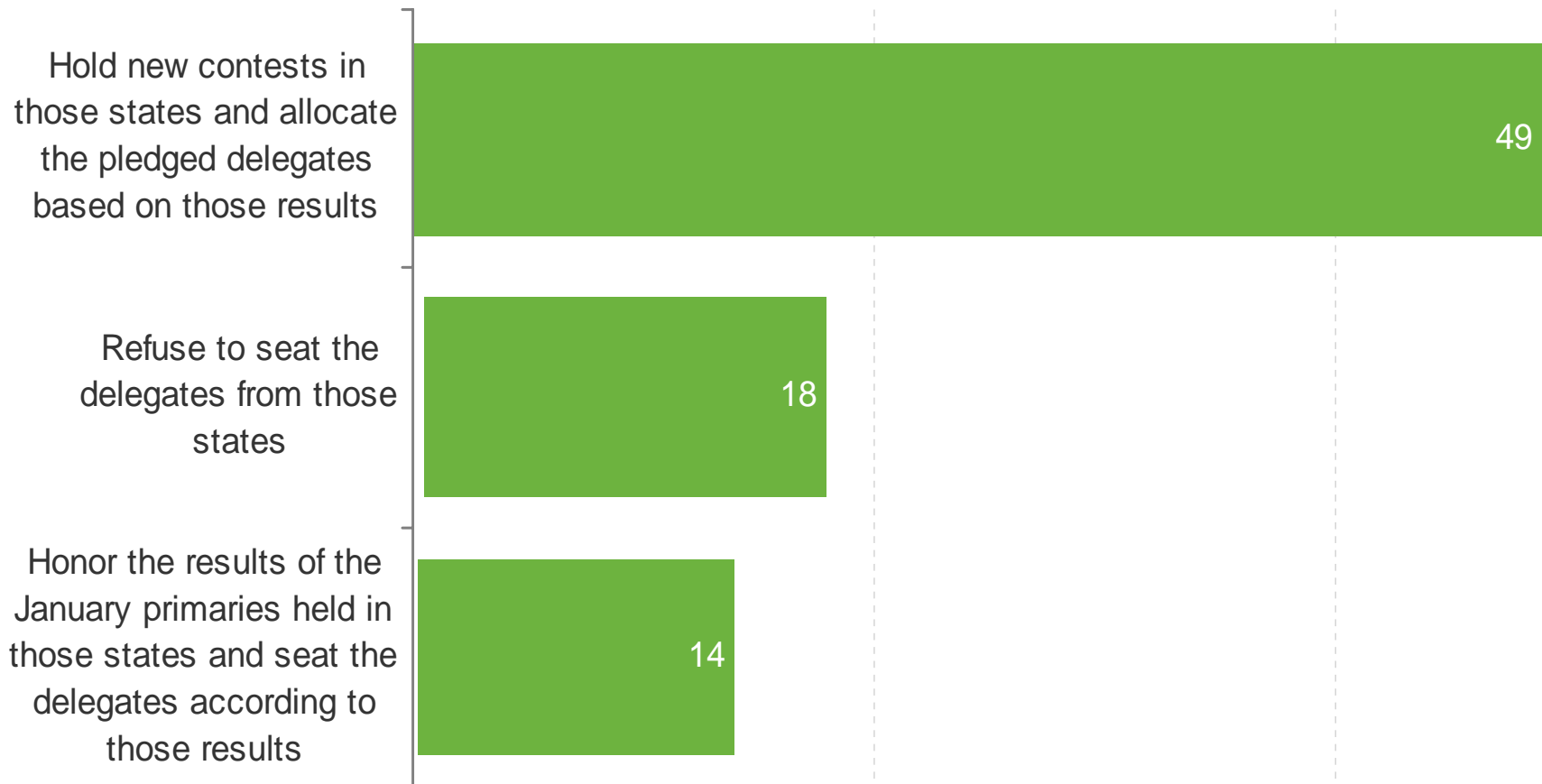
Barack Obama seen as candidate most likely to beat McCain

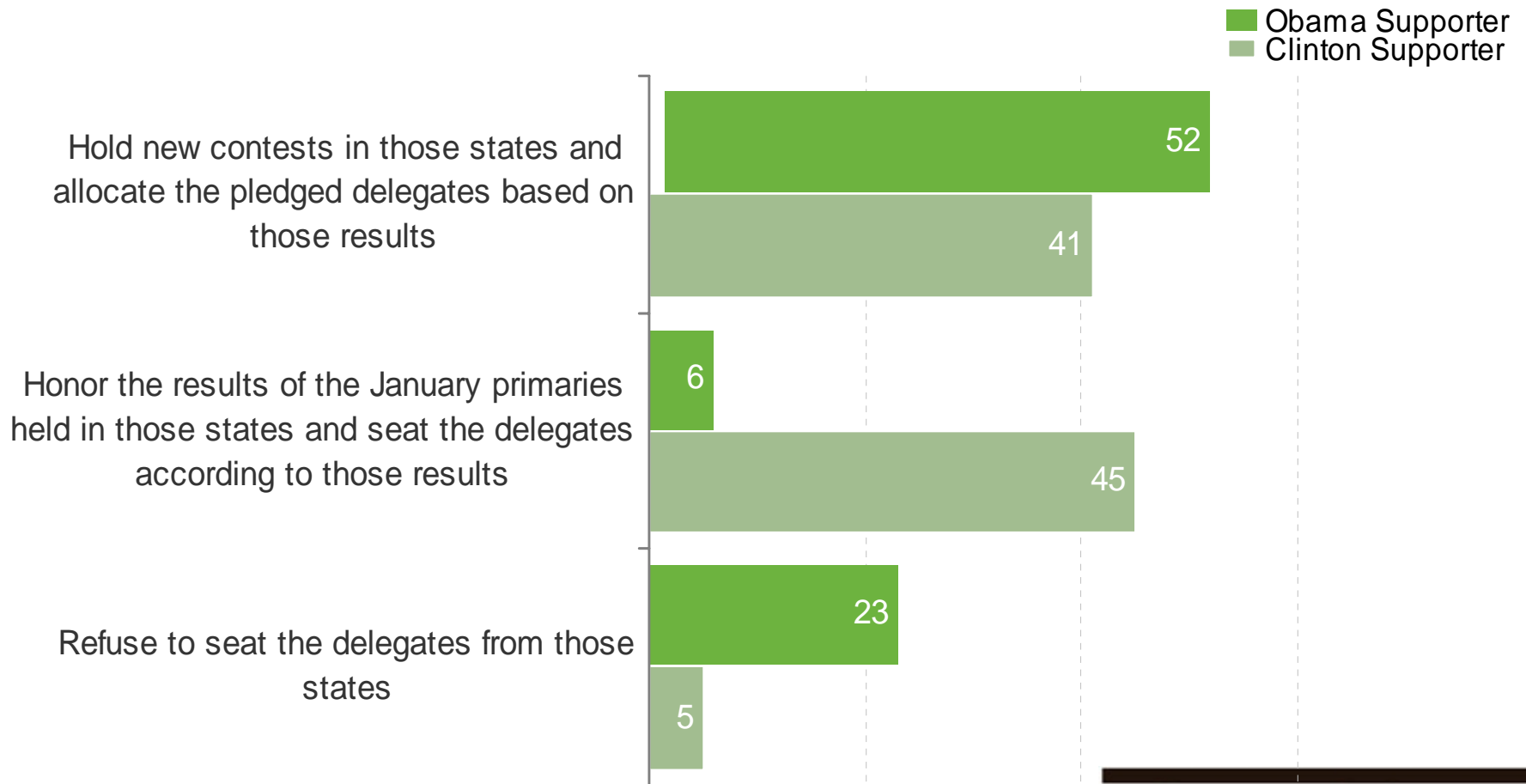
Support for new contests in FL and MI overwhelming

What would you prefer the Democratic Party do about the delegates from Florida and Michigan?



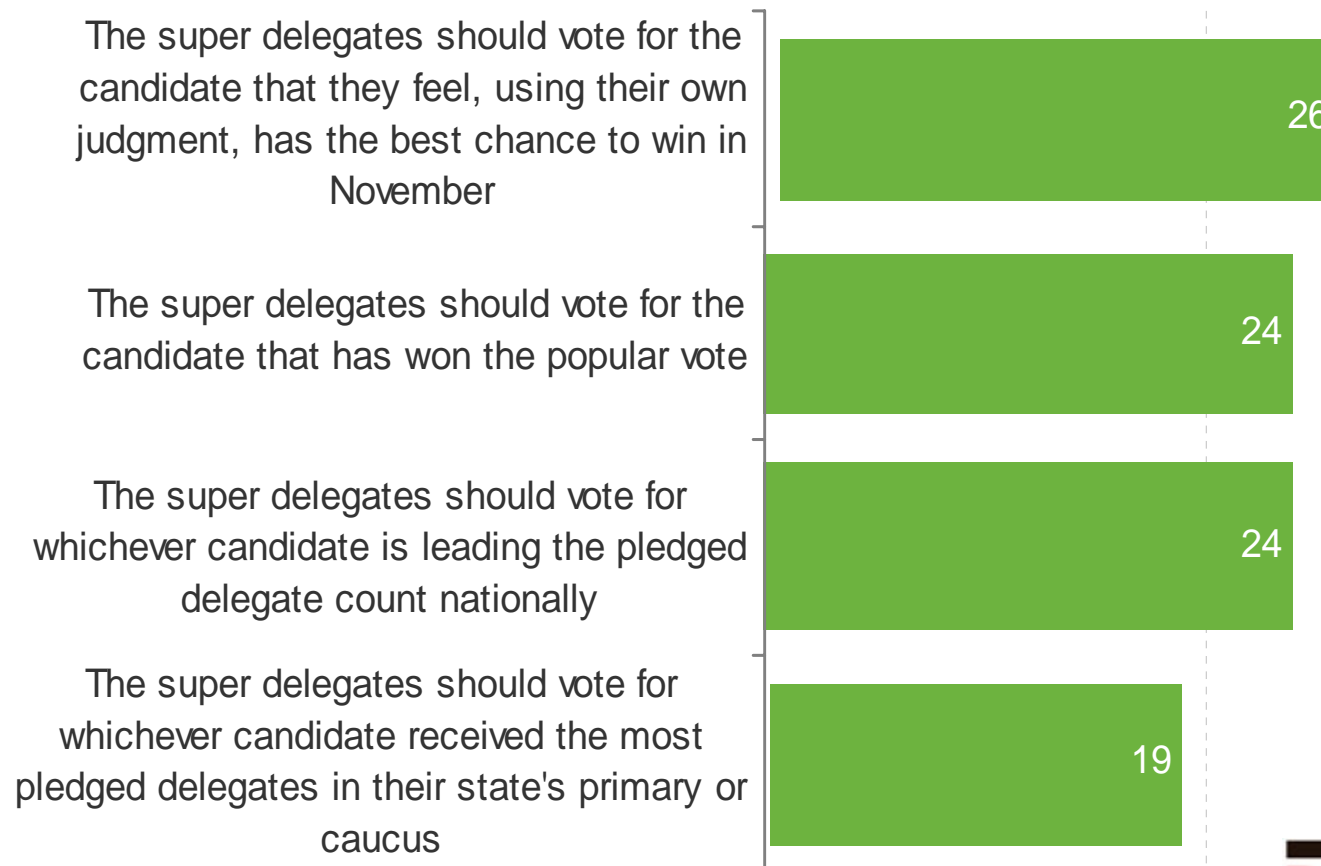
Obama supporters prefer new contests in FL, MI

What would you prefer the Democratic Party do about the delegates from Florida and Michigan?



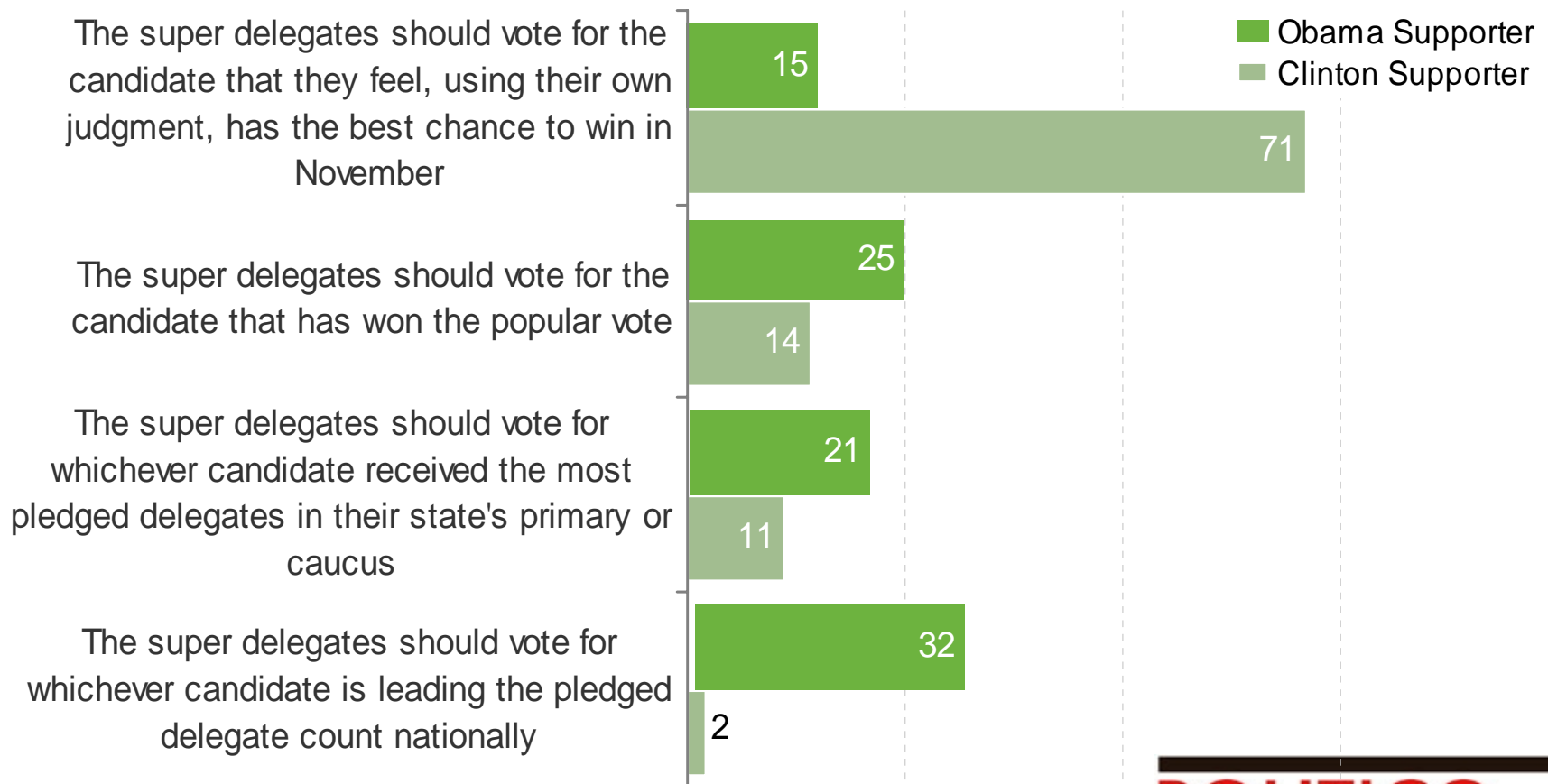
Participants split on what should guide super delegates in their vote

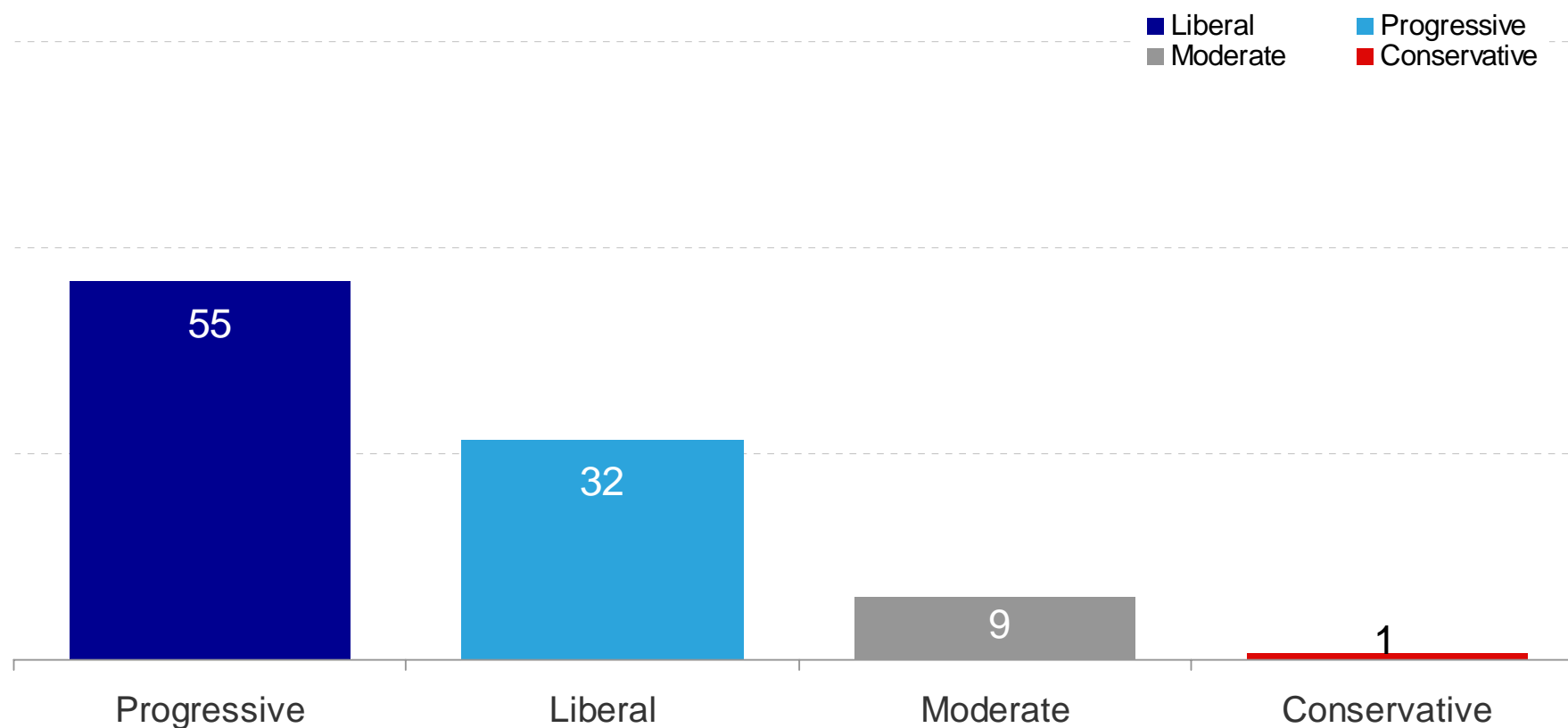
Clinton supporters strongly prefer delegates vote with their own judgment
